- Copies of Important Documents (kept seperately)

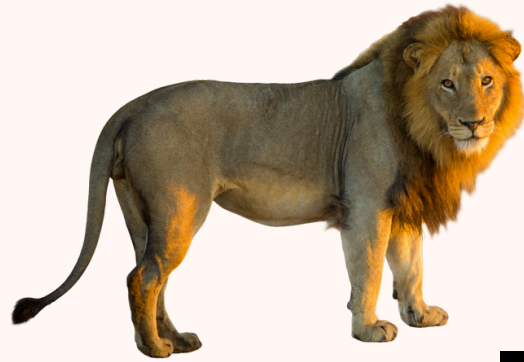
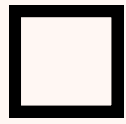

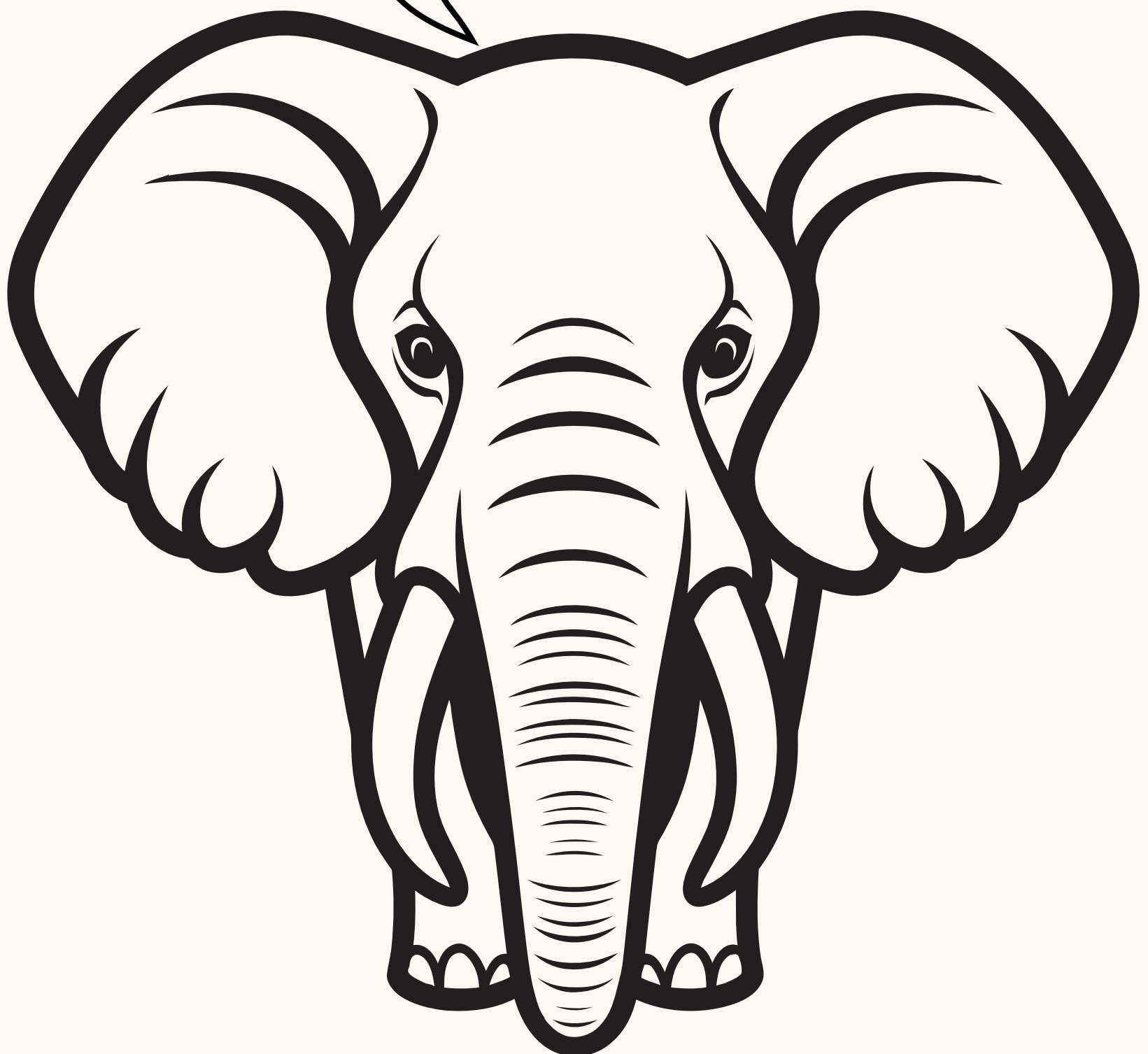
# Elephant

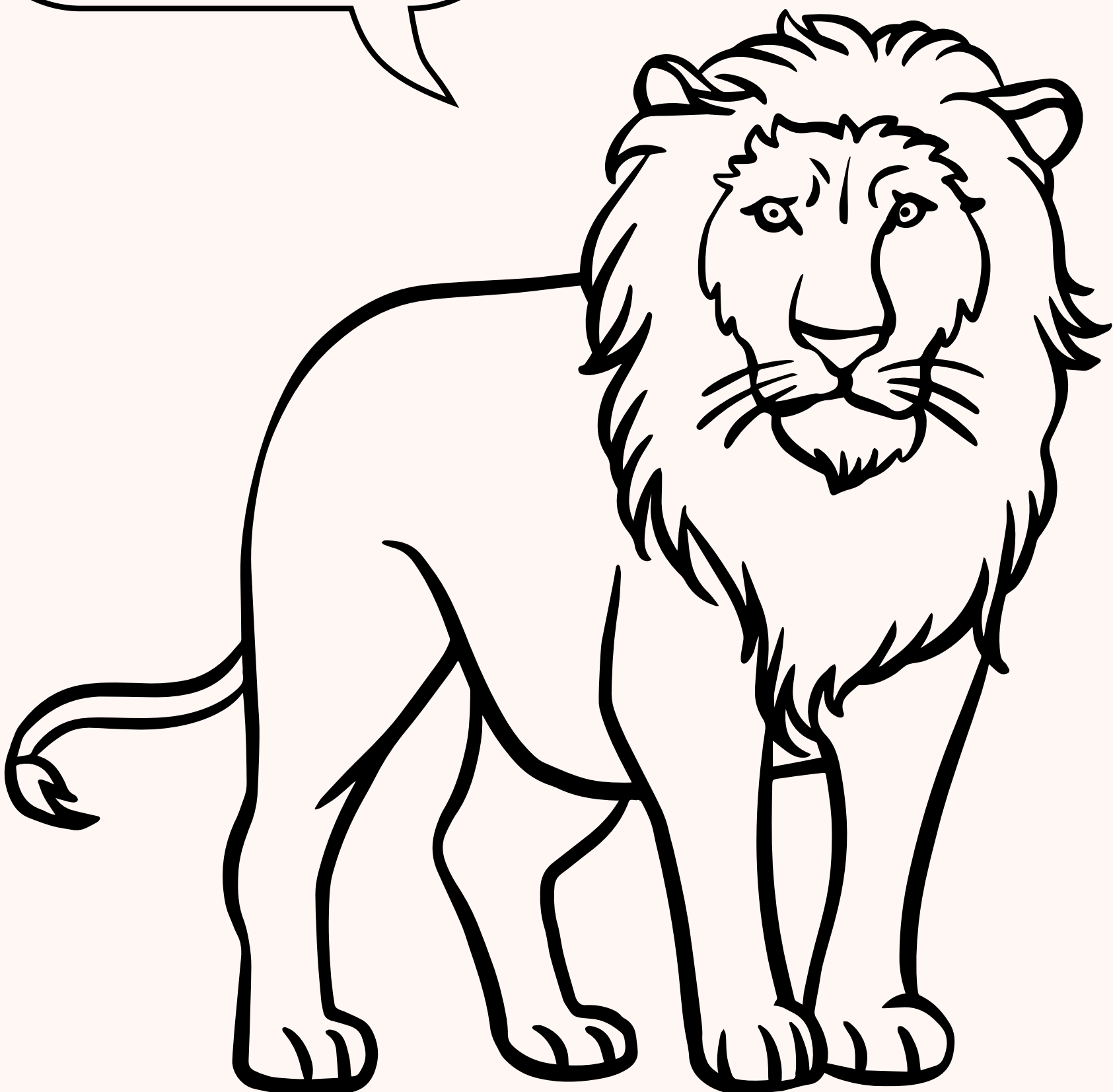
## Lion

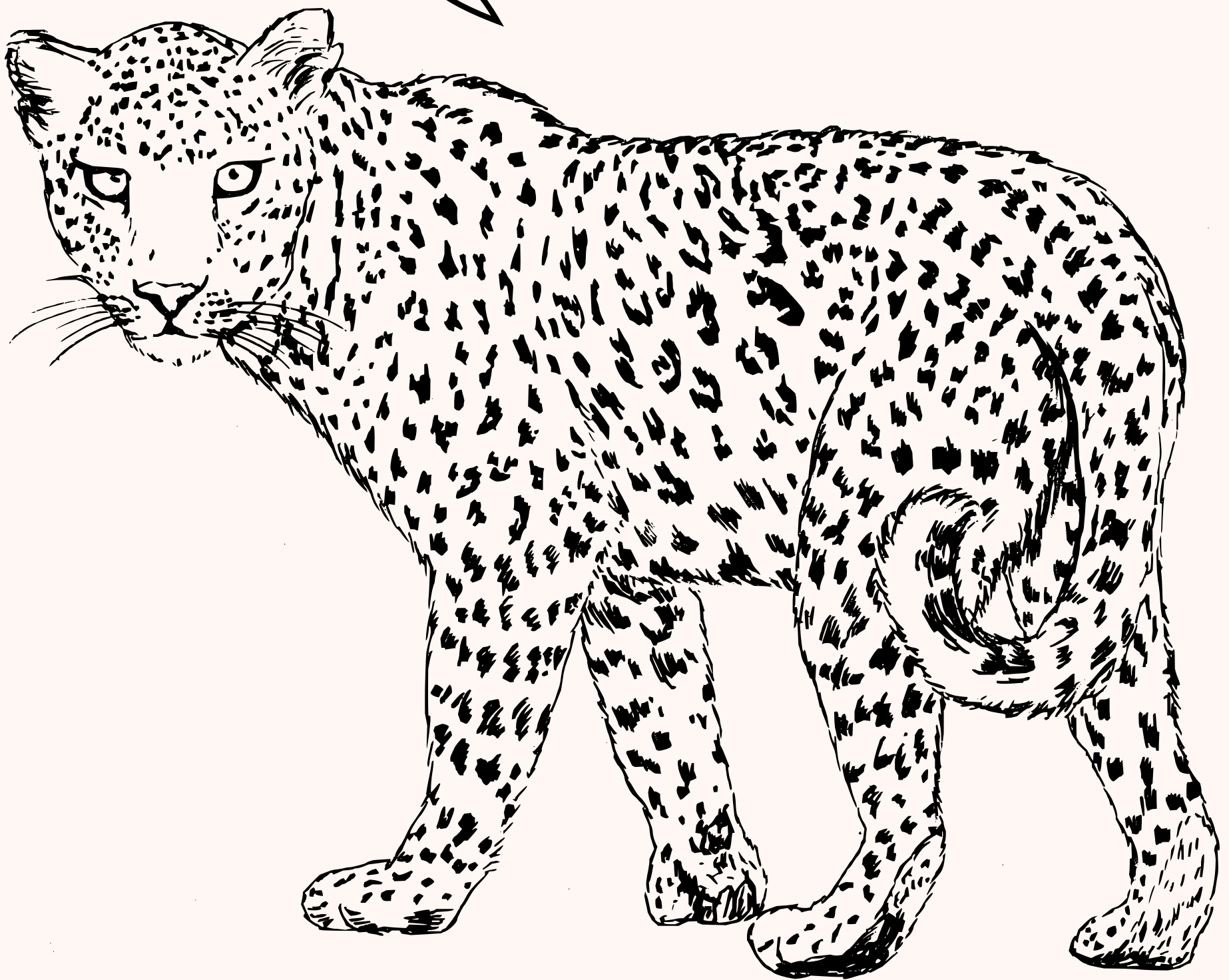
# Leopard

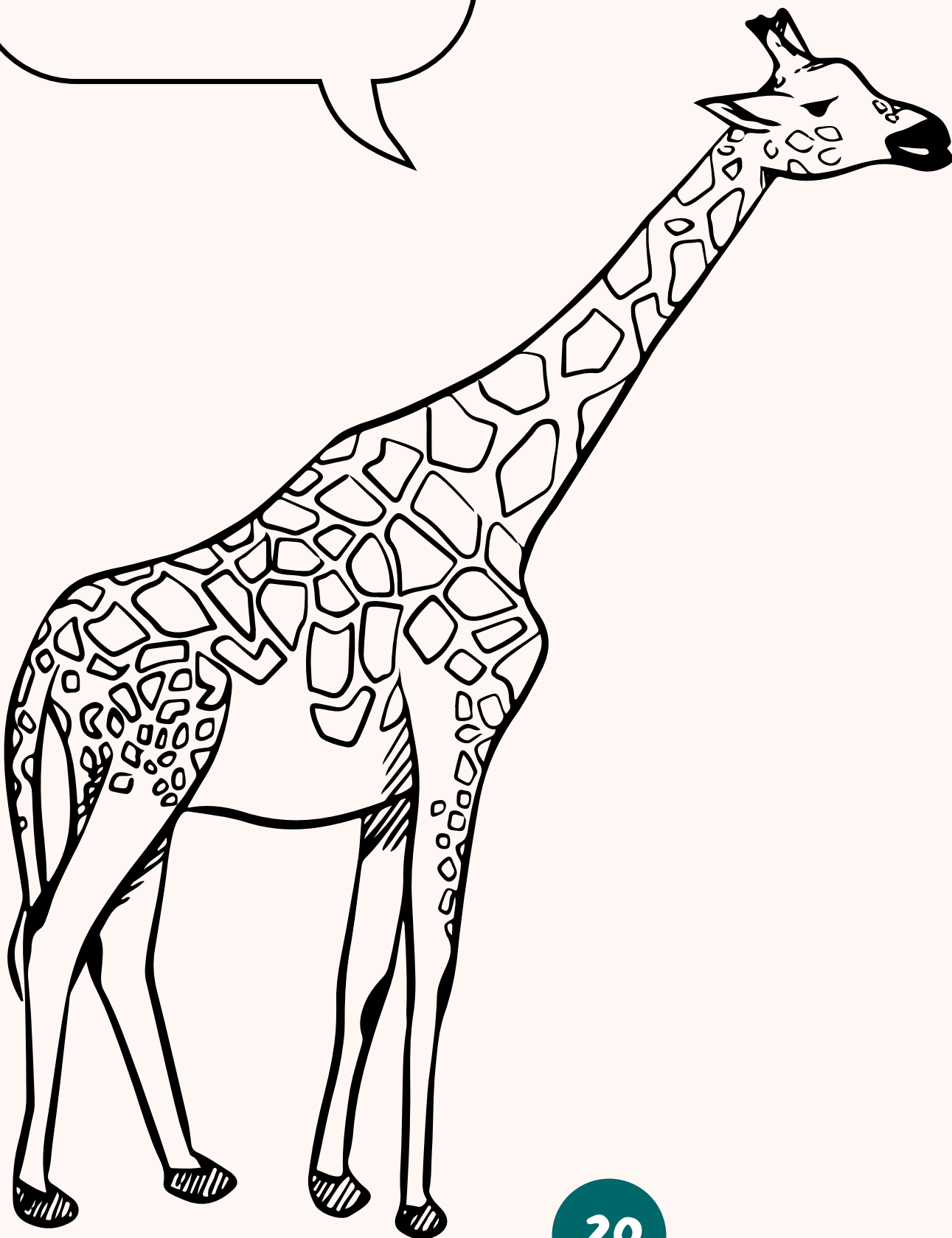

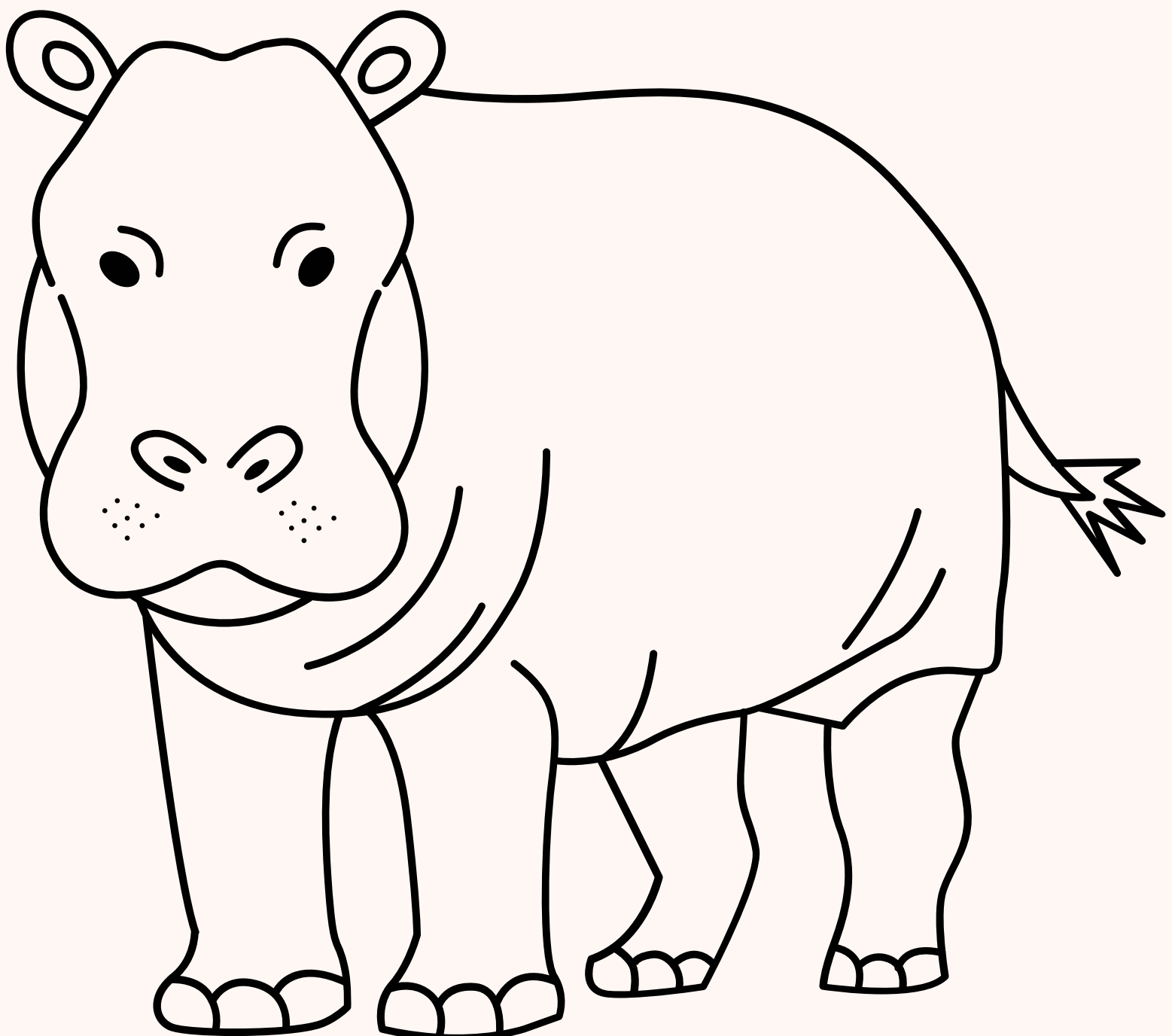
# Hippo

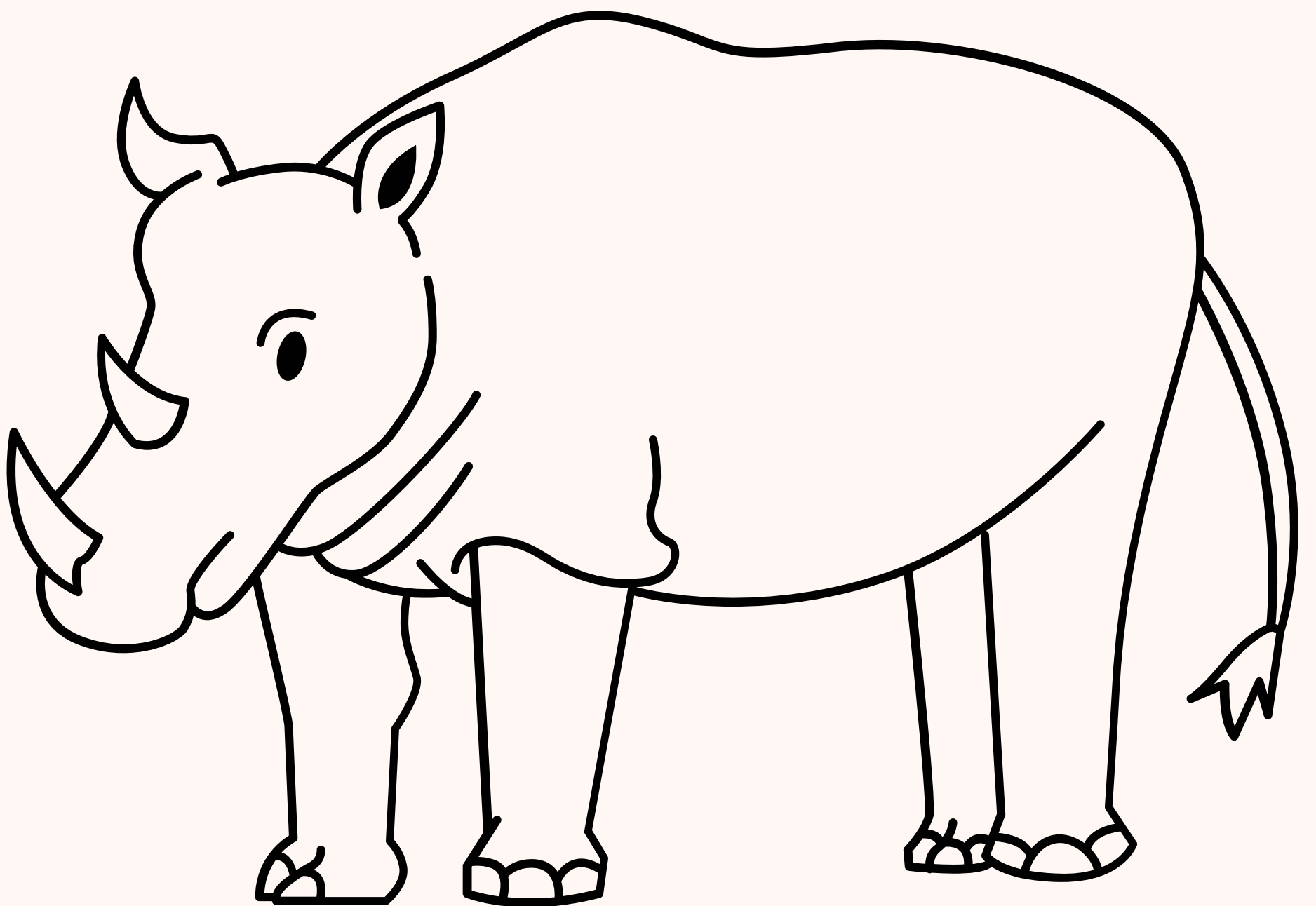
# Rhino
