Clothing

- Comfortable Safari Outfits (lightweight, breathable)
- Extra Socks & Underwear
- Sturdy Shoes / Walking Shoes
- Swimwear (if warm weather)
- Sandals (if warm weather)
- Hat or cap for sun protection
- Warm layer (for cool mornings & evenings)
- Light rain jacket or windbreaker

Toiletries and Personal Care

- Wet wipes or hand sanitizer
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Hairbrush / Comb
- Tissues / Toilet Paper (travel packs)
- Small Towel or Face Cloth
- Sunscreen (kid-friendly, high SPF)
- Insect Repellent
- Small first aid kit (plasters, antiseptic, basic meds)

Entertainment & Comfort

- Colouring books, sketch pad, or small craft set
- Card games or travel games
- Book or e-reader
- Headphones & playlist/audio stories

- Copies of Important Documents (kept separately)




Colour the Lilac Breasted Roller!


Elephant


Lion


Leopard




Hippo


Rhino

Grunt! Hear me stomp!




Stomp, stomp, little rhino,

Marching proudly day and night!




